THE TWO CONSTANT, UNDERLYING THEMES OF THIS SERIES:

1. GOD CARES ABOUT YOUR SUCCESS, IN EVERY PART OF YOUR LIFE.

“So Moses told the people, “You must be careful to obey all the commands of the Lord your God, following His instructions in every detail. Stay on the path that the Lord your God has commanded you to follow. Then you will live long and prosperous lives...”

2. YOUR SUCCESS HINGES ON YOUR OBEDIENCE TO GOD, IN EVERY PART OF YOUR LIFE...

...ESPECIALLY THE PRIVATE PARTS OF YOUR LIFE.

“You must not commit adultery.”

Exodus 20:14 (NLT)

4 WAYS WE CAN KEEP DISAPPOINTMENT FROM TURNING INTO REGRET:

1. RECOGNIZE THAT EVERYTHING STARTS IN YOUR HEART, BEFORE IT HAPPENS IN YOUR LIFE.

“You have heard the commandment that says, ‘You must not commit adultery.’ But I say, anyone who even looks at a woman with lust has already committed adultery with her in his heart.”

Matthew 5:27-28 (NLT)

2. COMMIT TO DOING RELATIONSHIPS GOD’S WAY & NOT THE WORLD’S WAY.

“Honor marriage, and guard the sacredness of sexual intimacy between wife and husband. God draws a firm line against casual and illicit sex.”

Hebrews 13:4 (message)

3. PROTECT YOURSELF & YOUR RELATIONSHIP BY CREATING FIRM, NON-NEGOTIABLE BOUNDARIES.

“If you go to bed with another man’s wife, you will destroy yourself by your own stupidity.”

Proverbs 6:32 (CEV)

“Run from sexual sin! No other sin so clearly affects the body as this one does. For sexual immorality is a sin against your own body.”

1st Corinthians 6:18 (NLT)

“The temptations in your life are no different from what others experience. And God is faithful. He will not allow the temptation to be more than you can stand. When you are tempted, He will show you a way out so that you can endure.”

4. TAKE THE GRACE THAT JESUS GIVES, AND GIVE IT TO YOURSELF, AND TO OTHERS.

“Teacher,” they said to Jesus, “this woman was caught in the act of adultery. The law of Moses says to stone her. What do You say?” They were trying to trap Him into saying something they could use against Him, but Jesus stooped down and wrote in the dust with His finger. They kept demanding an answer, so He stood up again and said, “All right, but let the one who has never sinned throw the first stone!” Then He stooped down again and wrote in the dust. When the accusers heard this, they slipped away one by one, beginning with the oldest, until only Jesus was left in the middle of the crowd with the woman. Then Jesus stood up again and said to the woman, “Where are your accusers? Didn’t even one of them condemn you?” “No, Lord,” she said. And Jesus said, “Neither do I. Go and sin no more.”
