## 5 THINGS JESUS WOULD SAY TO TIGER WOODS

### 1. ON YOUR WORST DAY EVER, GOD IS ALWAYS READY TO HELP...JUST ASK.

*“Generous in love—God, give grace! Huge in mercy—wipe out my bad record. Scrub away my guilt, soak out my sins in Your laundry. I know how bad I’ve been; my sins are staring me down.”*

Psalm 51:1-2 (message)

*“God is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble.”*

Psalm 46:1 (NLT)

### 2. HEALING BEGINS WHEN WE BEGIN TO BE HONEST.

*“I know about my sins, and I cannot forget my terrible guilt. You are really the One I have sinned against; I have disobeyed You and have done wrong. So it is right and fair for You to correct and punish me.”*

Psalm 51:3-4 (CEV)

### 3. CREATING NEW HABITS STARTS BY RECOGNIZING YOUR PAST PATTERNS.

*“I have sinned and done wrong since the day I was born. But You want complete honesty, so teach me true wisdom.”*

Psalm 51:5-6 (CEV)

### 4. ONLY GOD CAN CLEANSE YOU FROM YOUR PAST & RENEW YOUR PURPOSE FOR THE FUTURE.

*“Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me.”*

Psalm 51:10 (NLT)

### 5. YOUR PAST MISTAKES DON’T DISQUALIFY YOU FROM A GREAT FUTURE... YOU JUST HAVE TO GROW THROUGH IT.

*“And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to His purpose for them. For God knew His people in advance, and He chose them to become like His Son.”*  
Romans 8:28-29 (NLT)

*“But when you follow your own wrong inclinations, your lives will produce these evil results: impure thoughts, eagerness for lustful pleasure, idolatry, spiritism (that is, encouraging the activity of demons), hatred and fighting, jealousy and anger, constant effort to get the best for yourself, complaints and criticisms, the feeling that everyone else is wrong except those in your own little group—and there will be wrong doctrine, envy, murder, drunkenness, wild parties, and all that sort of thing. Let me tell you again, as I have before, that anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God. But when the Holy Spirit controls our lives He will produce this kind of fruit in us: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.”*
